## **Clubhouse to Lakeview 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project**

You are receiving this postcard because we have completed rebuilding a 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Clubhouse Substation in Greensville County, Virginia and our Lakeview Substation in Halifax County, North Carolina.



This project was completed to ensure the continued safety and reliability of the electric grid.

Between summer 2022 and fall 2023, we replaced aging transmission infrastructure with upgraded equipment. The new electric transmission weathering steel H-frame structures will require less maintenance over time and have a longer service life than the original wooden structures.

Through the end of this year, crews will remove construction equipment, materials, and access matting. You may periodically notice crews restoring the right of way to its pre-existing condition through the spring. Thank you for your patience while we rehabilitate vegetation.
