Clubhouse to Lakeview 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project - Roanoke Canal Trail Alert

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to providing updates on our projects in your community. We are rebuilding a 230 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our Clubhouse Substation in Greensville County, Virginia and our Lakeview Substation in Halifax County, North Carolina.

As part of this project, transmission wires over Roanoke Canal Trail need to be replaced. For the safety of our crews and trail users, a portion of the trail will be temporarily closed and there will be no fishing access at the Roanoke River.

- July 27 August 4, 2023: No Fishing at the Roanoke River (near the Roanoke Canal Bridge). Roanoke Canal Trail OPEN.
- September 2 15, 2023: No Fishing at the Roanoke River (near the Roanoke Canal Bridge). Roanoke Canal Trail CLOSED (between the Trail Head and near Rochelle Pond).

Signs will be posted, and flaggers will direct trail users away from the closed section.

The Roanoke Rapids Lake Day Use Area and parking lot will remain open, but Trail Head access will be closed. Trail users are encouraged to park and access the trail at the Roanoke Canal Museum.

Oakwood Avenue neighbors may notice increased construction traffic this summer and fall. We are dedicated to working safely and courteously in your community. Thank you for your patience while we complete this important reliability project.
