# Local Power Line Project Announcement

## New Road-Middleburg 115 kV Electric Transmission Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable electricity to our neighbors. As such, we are planning to rebuild the existing 115 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between our New Road Substation and our Middleburg Substation traveling through Prince William, Loudoun, and Fauquier counties.

After more than six decades of operation, the wooden H-frame structures and related components are at the end of their service life and need to be replaced. We plan to rebuild this 5.8-mile line within the existing right of way corridor using brown, weathering steel H-frame structures that are comparable in height to the existing structures.

You may see field crews in or near the right of way corridor gathering information as we continue planning this project. We are also currently working with the counties on permitting requirements and other considerations. Once plans are further along and prior to starting construction, we plan to hold an informational open house for landowners to learn more about the project. We will continue to keep you updated as activities progress.

Once all necessary permits and approvals are received, we anticipate construction beginning in summer 2020 and line energization by the end of 2021.
