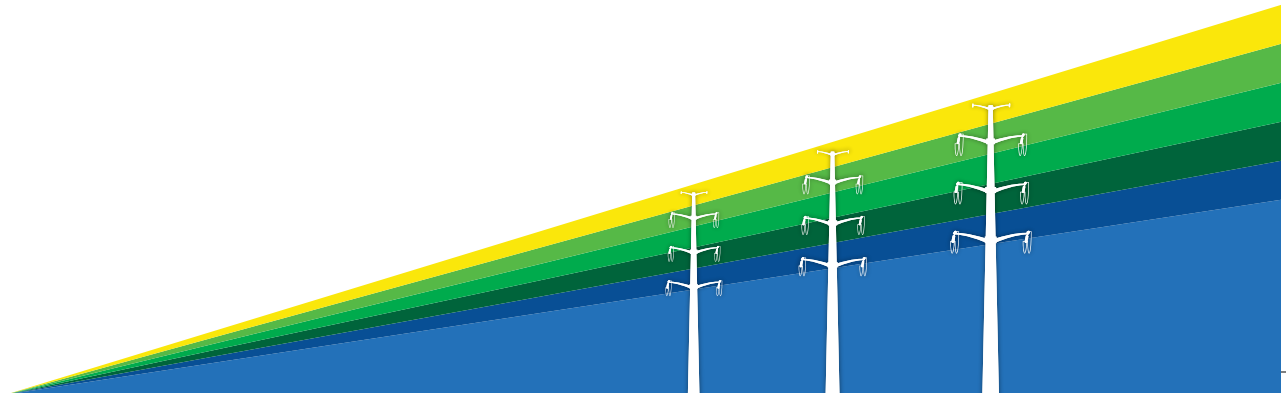

Dominion Energy is dedicated to providing safe, reliable, affordable, and increasingly clean energy. We are preparing to construct a new electric transmission line, generally northwest of Dulles Airport, connecting Golden and Mars Substations.



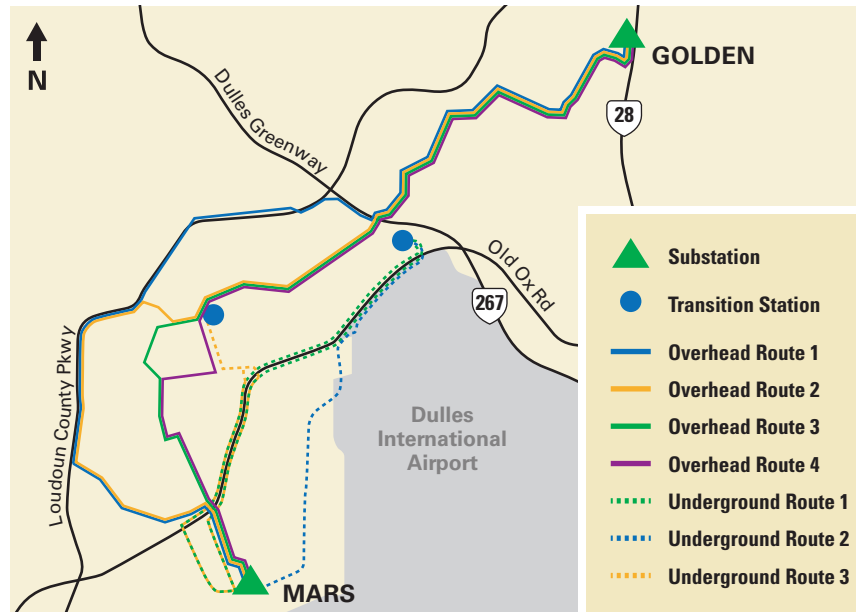

Rapid growth in electrical demand in the high-tech sector, which includes data centers in eastern Loudoun County, has resulted in the need for new electric transmission infrastructure. This reliability project, named the Golden-Mars 500-230 kV Electric Transmission Project will allow Dominion to bring bulk electricity into the area and complete a transmission loop through Data Center Alley. These reliability projects aim to address Loudoun County's growing energy needs.

As we work with state and local leaders to route and site new electric infrastructure in eastern Loudoun County, we also value your input. We encourage you to attend one of the upcoming community meetings to provide your feedback on the initial transmission line routing options. Virtual and in-person sessions are planned on July 30, 31, and August 1, 2024, to gather input and provide project details.
