Rollercoaster Substation Interconnection Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to keeping you informed of upcoming projects in your community. You are receiving this letter because we are planning to build a new substation in Hanover County, Virginia.

The new Rollercoaster Substation, located across from Kings Dominion off Doswell Road (GPIN 7893-02-7643), will be built to connect a new solar renewable power facility to the electric transmission grid. In addition to the new substation, we will replace some electric transmission structures on an existing electric transmission line that runs parallel to Doswell Road.

We are currently in the engineering and permitting phase of the project, and we plan to submit applications for both a Conditional Use Permit to locate the substation facility in an agricultural-zoned area and a Special Exception Permit for approval of the security fence around the energized substation equipment.

The application will be available for viewing at the Hanover County Planning Department. The Planning Department will notify all adjacent property owners of the time, day, and place of the public hearings to be held on this application.
