Unity Substation Project

Lunenburg County, Virginia

Project Overview: As new industries enter the region and overall growth continues, there is a need to install new electric transmission infrastructure that will enable secure and reliable service to residents and businesses in Lunenburg County. This new substation will connect an existing 500 kV electric transmission line to a new 230 kV electric transmission line, known as the Unity – Tunstall route.

The Unity Substation will be built on approximately 50 acres of land, just outside of the Town of Kenbridge. Construction on the new substation is expected to begin in January 2024. Substation construction will be completed in 2026.
