SCAN HERE TO LEARN MORE we would like to provide an update on the Staunton to Craigsville 115 kilovolt (kV) Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project.

This project rebuilt approximately
4.6 miles of the electric transmission
line between Staunton Substation and
Trimbles Mill in Augusta County,
Virginia. In spring 2023, we completed

construction on this section of transmission line. New H-Frame structures and equipment were installed to help maintain reliable electric service in your area.

Construction on the remainder of the line, from Trimbles Mill to Craigsville Substation, was originally expected to begin in early 2024. We now tentatively plan to begin construction on this phase of the project in Fall 2027.

The decision to reschedule this project will not impact the quality of your electric service, and the existing infrastructure remains safe and secure. We will continue to update you on the project as it progresses.
