Staunton-Craigsville 115 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to providing the latest information on projects in the communities we serve. You are receiving this postcard because we would like to provide an update on a 115 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line rebuild project in Augusta County.

You previously heard from us about the need to rebuild the transmission line segment between Staunton and Craigsville substations to replace equipment that has been in service for nearly a century. In July 2022, we began construction on the section of this line outside Staunton Substation and worked southwest toward Trimbles Mill Substation. We have completed construction and energized this 4.6 mile section of the transmission line, shown in blue on the adjacent map.

In early 2024, we expect to begin construction on the remaining section of this transmission line, which spans approximately 10 miles from south of Trimbles Mill Substation to Craigsville Substation. This section is shown in orange on the adjacent map. We expect to complete construction and begin restoration in early 2025.

Thank you for your patience as we complete this important project to maintain safe and reliable service for customers. We will continue to keep you updated as activities progress.
