

Project Overview

Dominion Energy is committed to working safely and courteously on or near your property. This proposed project is to rebuild the existing 230 kilovolt (kV) Suffolk Swamp Winfall electric transmission line. No new right of way is needed. The station, along with new transmission infrastructure, is needed to accommodate increased demand and maintain reliability for our customers.

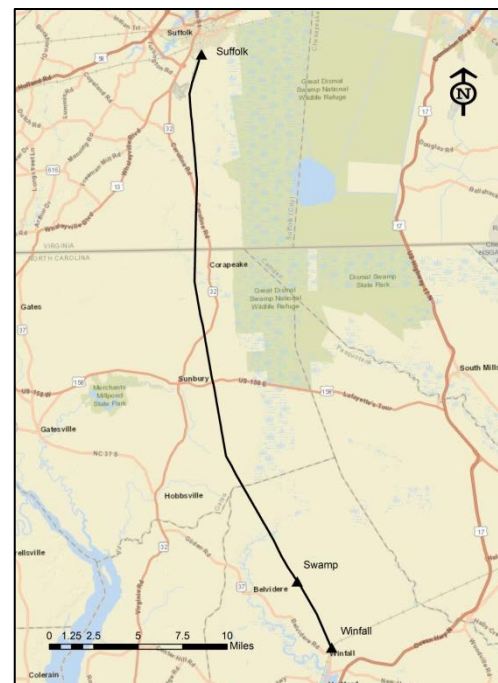
This electric transmission line and the existing wooden structures have been in operation for over five decades and have reached the end of their service life. A total of 283 structures must be replaced to maintain continued reliability.

Beginning in the fall 2020, we plan to start building roads to access the right of way. Construction, including the installation of new weathering steel structures, will begin in 2021. Construction is expected to be complete in 2023.

It is always our goal to build our transmission projects in a manner that:

- Provides long-term reliability and durability without excessive maintenance
- Delivers operational system flexibility to meet future needs
- Complies with mandatory standards to ensure safety and reliability
- Minimizes impact to the local area and environment
