
Trowbridge Solar Interconnection and Line Rebuild Project

Martin, Pitt, Washington Counties, North Carolina

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to providing safe, reliable, affordable, and increasingly clean electricity to our neighbors. This project will connect renewable power from the Macadamia Solar project in Washington County, North Carolina, to the electric grid. It will also upgrade electric transmission lines in Martin, Pitt, and Washington counties to support this new renewable energy generation source.

Overview: This project consists of three distinct components.

- 1. Expand Trowbridge Substation in Washington County.
- 2. Rebuild 1.5 miles of 115 kilovolt (kV) Line 25 in Martin and Washington counties.
- 3. Rebuild 20 miles of 230 kV Line 218 in Martin and Pitt counties from Everetts Substation to Duke Energy Interconnection in Greenville.
