PROMOTING SUSTAINABILITY

Dominion Energy partners with the Four Cities Educational Compact to underwrite an energy efficient home built by high school students in the carpentry program.

EnergyShare is a heating bill assistance program implemented across the Dominion Energy footprint. In Ohio, EnergyShare is administered in collaboration with The Salvation Army providing support for individuals and families facing financial hardship.

SUPPORTING HISTORICALLY UNDER RESOURCED STUDENTS

HBCU Promise

Dominion Energy committed \$25 million to 11 historically black colleges and universities. Ohio's Central State University and Wilberforce University both received \$500,000 to support endowments, scholarships, and educational programs.

Educational Equity Scholarship Program

Dominion Energy committed \$10 million to the Educational Equity Scholarship program to assist historically under resourced students residing in its service territory. The scholarship program assists students who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs.

Say Yes Cleveland!

\$500,000 to Say Yes Cleveland which provides tuition assistance for eligible students graduating from the Cleveland Municipal School District. These scholarships will provide full, four-year scholarships to degree and certificate programs at public institutions as well as vocational trade opportunities.

Building Hispanic Talent Initiative

In partnership with the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU), Dominion Energy launched the Building Hispanic Talent Initiative, a \$2 million-dollar program to develop Hispanic leaders in energy.
