NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARINGS

Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc.'s Application for a Mid-Period Adjustment to Increase Base Rates for the Recovery of Electric Fuel Costs Docket No. 2022-259-E

Why is this Notice Important?

- This Notice is for customers of Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. (the Company) and interested persons.
- Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. filed an Application with the Public Service Commission of South Carolina to increase its base rates for the recovery of electric fuel costs.

What is Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. asking the Public Service Commission to approve?

- An increase to the Base Fuel Cost Component (Fc) to the Base Rate for the recovery
 of electric fuel costs approved in Docket No. 2022-2-E, Order No. 2022-290.
- The increase of the Base Fuel Cost Component (Fc), if approved, to take effect for bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of November 2022.
- Removal of Order No. 2022-290, Ordering Paragraph 14's requirement to submit a forecast "of the expected fuel factor to be set at its next annual fuel proceeding" for the June 30 quarter and resume for the September 30 quarter.

What does Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. estimate the impact of this case will be on customers?

- The Company projects that for a residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month, the average monthly bill would rise from \$132.79 to \$151.34, or 13.97%, inclusive of revenue taxes.
- The Company projects that for a commercial customer with a 500 kVA demand, using 150,000 kWh per month, the average monthly bill would rise from \$16,485 to \$19,267, or 16.88%, inclusive of revenue taxes.
- The Company projects that for an industrial customer with a 10,000 kW demand, using 6,570,000 kWh per month (90% load factor), the average monthly bill would rise from \$456,541 to \$578,415, or 26.70%, inclusive of revenue taxes.
- *The case was filed according to S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-865(D) and S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-823 and, these hearings have been scheduled according to S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-865 and S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-817.
