Curtailments

- ▶ Firm Transportation has highest priority of service on interstate pipelines & DESC
- ▶ Interruptible Customers are curtailed by category
- ▶ Summary of 2021-2022 Winter Curtailments
 - Nov 2021 – Gas days 11-23, 11-24, 11-30
 - Dec 2021 – Gas days 1, 21-24
 - Jan 2022 – Gas days 3-4; 7-8, 10-11, 15-18, 20-31
 - Feb 2022 – Gas days 5-8; 13-15
- ▶ Colder weather increases amount of gas needed for firm customers which requires curtailments of interruptible customers
- ▶ All upstream pipelines are fully subscribed

Emergency Gas

- Tariff definition of Emergency Service- Supplemental deliveries of natural gas that may be required to forestall irreparable injury to life or property including environmental emergencies.
- Emergency Gas requests must be made to Gas Control
- Emergency gas price- \$20.00 per dekatherm, plus the higher of: (a) the monthly contract index price for the applicable month as published in Inside F.E.R.C.'s Gas Market Report, "Prices of Spot Gas Delivered to Pipelines," "Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corp.- Zone 3 (pooling points)," "Index," plus the one hundred percent (100%) load factor rate under Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company LLC's currently effective Rate Schedule FT for deliveries from Zone 3 to Zone 5, including applicable fuel retention and surcharges, or (b) the absolute high price for the day of consumption as published in Gas Daily in the "Daily price survey," "Citygates," "Transco, zone 5 delivered," "Absolute," high end of the range

Penalty Gas

- Gas used during a curtailment order
- Penalty Gas price- \$50.00 per dekatherm, plus the higher of: (a) the monthly contract index price for the applicable month as published in Inside F.E.R.C.'s Gas Market Report, "Prices of Spot Gas Delivered to Pipelines," "Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corp.- Zone 3 (pooling points)," "Index," plus the one hundred percent (100%) load factor rate under Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company LLC's currently effective Rate Schedule FT for deliveries from Zone 3 to Zone 5, including applicable fuel retention and surcharges, or (b) the absolute high price for the day of consumption as published in Gas Daily in the "Daily price survey," "Citygates," "Transco, zone 5 delivered," "Absolute," high end of the range
