Project Overview



HARNESSING RELIABLE ENERGY

Dominion Energy South Carolina’s (DESC) East Edisto Project has been proposed to ensure reliable energy is available for residential, commercial and industrial developments in the fast-growing areas of East Edisto, Long Savannah, Watson Hill and Poplar Grove.

This project will require the installation of approximately 14 miles of 12” steel transmission natural gas line from Summers Drive (Dorchester County) to Bees Ferry Road (Dorchester and Charleston counties). The line will be installed underground, with three valve stations. Eight miles of the project will follow an existing utility corridor (in existence since the 1960’s) with the additional six miles planned along and adjacent to an existing DESC electric transmission easement.

Extending the existing distribution system will enable DESC to provide the additional capacity and flexibility needed to meet current and anticipated customer demand for natural gas, providing reliable, affordable energy to more customers.
