Re: Notice of planned activities along SCE&G's existing Lake Murray to Harbison 115kV Line

Dear Resident:

As SCE&G prepares to meet Columbia's growing energy needs, we will be rebuilding an existing electrical transmission line in your area. This line will help ensure a reliable supply of electricity to SCE&G customers.

In 2017, you may notice or have contact with SCE&G, and other SCE&G-authorized work crews, as they work on the electric transmission line that crosses on or near the referenced parcel of property. Crews will be performing the many activities associated with power line construction. These activities include flagging/staking pole locations, installing foundations, removing and erecting poles, removing and installing wires, and cutting/trimming trees where needed. In some cases, temporary road lane closures may be necessary. All of the above activities will be conducted in a safe and efficient manner, will occur over the next several months, and will be coordinated with the appropriate agencies.

In addition to normal weekday hours, weekend work hours and night time work may be necessary in rare cases to meet critical project schedules and to meet road closure permit requirements. Final cleanup and right-of-way restoration will occur at the conclusion of the project.

A community workshop will be held on **Thursday, July 21** to give you an opportunity to learn more about the project, view maps with the route and how it might affect your property, and ask questions. The workshop will be informal, and you are invited to drop by anytime from **5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** The workshop will be held at the following location:
