



# River Neck to Kingsburg

## Natural Gas Project Overview



### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Dominion Energy South Carolina’s (DESC) River Neck to Kingsburg Project is a natural gas project being proposed to provide the additional capacity and flexibility required to meet both current and anticipated customer growth while also representing our ongoing commitment to provide safe, reliable and affordable service in the eastern South Carolina region.

The project will run along Old River Road near Pamplico in Florence County, SC and will require the installation of approximately 15 miles of 16” natural gas transmission main line. The line will be installed underground and will run parallel to an existing 8” DESC natural gas transmission main, which will remain in service. Existing rights-of-way (ROW) will be used, but some new ROW will be acquired adjacent to the existing DESC easement.

Existing permanent easements for the project are primarily 40 feet wide. In most cases, 10 feet of permanent easement, adjacent to the existing 40 feet, and 25 feet of temporary easement is being acquired for the project. Additional temporary workspaces are being acquired at crossing locations, material and equipment storage areas and other locations along the construction corridor to allow for safe work areas during construction.
