REACH

Winter can be hard for many elderly, disabled and others facing hardships or emergencies. That's why Dominion Energy is working with The Salvation Army to help these individuals pay their gas bill. Customers must first apply for HEAT or LIHEAP before applying for REACH.

Donations from Dominion Energy customers, employees and shareholders fund the REACH program. It helps low-income customers who are 60 or older or are disabled, or have children in the home under the age of 3. Customers who meet the criteria and can provide proof of veteran status qualify for additional assistance.
