

Net Metering Proof of Insurance

Dominion Energy's Net Metering Terms and Conditions (see excerpt below) requires customers provide proof of insurance at the generating facility.

<p>B. Company Notification</p> <p>1. The prospective Customer shall notify the Company prior to starting any construction or installation of the proposed Generator (including the addition of capacity to the Customer's existing Generator) with the Company's distribution facilities. The Company suggests that the prospective Customer provide the Company with such notification as soon as possible and, preferably, before the Customer enters into an agreement to purchase the proposed Generator. Upon the Customer's notification to the Company, as described in this Section XXV.B, the Company will provide the Customer the proposed Generator's maximum capacity limitations and any other suitability requirements, which the Company will need to be completed in advance of the proposed Generator's installation. The prospective Customer's notification to the Company shall include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. An <i>Agricultural Net Metering or Net Metering Interconnection Notification</i>, Form NMIN Effective 07-01-2020 ("Notification Form") with Sections 1 through 4 completed; andb. A certificate of insurance or other proof of insurance (as required in Paragraph XXV.I, below); andc. The generating capacity of the proposed Generator. <p>The Company must approve the prospective Customer's Notification Form prior to the installation of the prospective Customer's new Generator or addition of capacity to the Customer's existing Generator.</p>	<p>I. Liability insurance</p> <p>1. A Customer with a Generator with an alternating current capacity not exceeding 10 kilowatts shall maintain homeowners, commercial or other insurance providing coverage of at least \$100,000 for the liability of the insured against loss arising out of the use of a Generator, and for a Generator with an alternating current capacity exceeding 10 kilowatts the coverage shall be in the amount of at least \$300,000.</p> <p>2. Customers are not required to purchase additional liability insurance where the Customer's existing insurance policy provides coverage against loss arising out of the use of a Generator by virtue of not explicitly excluding coverage for such loss.</p>
